Note on Feiten System Class

Cost for this class is \$1,000. The recommended tuner for the class is a Peterson model 490. Our cost for the tuner is \$495, including tax and shipping. Let us know in advance if you would like us to purchase one for you at this price.

The purpose of this letter is to recap the information you have gathered on our program and to make sure that you fully understand what the Galloup School is offering you in terms of your class projects, living environment, tuition and school schedule. Please feel free to call us if you have more questions or concerns.

In the **Masters Program** you will build four different instruments. This includes in the first Eight-week term an electric guitar and an acoustic bass, 14 fret or 12 fret acoustic guitar. In the second and third Eight-week terms you will have a choice of building any two instruments choosing from a classical guitar, set-neck electric with hand wound pickups, an arch top. The cost for the Masters Program is \$17,500 and this includes everything you need while you attend classes. Housing is fully furnished with a complete kitchen and provided free of charge but students are responsible for their own food and entertainment. You will need to supply your linens for a full size bed and towels. Housing is offered free of charge and is not included in the cost of tuition but for students who require alternative living arrangements housing can be secured locally at the expense of the student. For the Masters Program we require a deposit of \$3,000 to enroll and we apply \$1000 to each eight-week term. The remainder of tuition is due as follows: on the first day of class, the 1st term \$5,500 is due, on the first day of the 2nd term \$4,500 is due and on the first day of the 3rd term \$4,500 is due.

In the **Journeyman program** you will have an option to build an electric guitar and an acoustic bass, 14 fret or 12 fret guitar. The cost for the Journeyman Program is \$6,500 and includes everything you need while you are attending classes. Housing is fully furnished with a complete kitchen and provided free of charge, but students are responsible for their own food and entertainment. You will need to supply your linens for a full size bed and towels. Housing is offered free of charge and is not included in the cost of tuition but for students who require alternative living arrangements housing can be secured locally at the expense of the student. For the Journeyman class we require a deposit of \$1,000 to enroll and the remainder \$5,500 is due on the first day of class.

The **Technicians Program** is a Four-day class that is offered on a Tuesday – Friday schedule and is also 8am – 5 pm, with a lunch break from noon – 1:00 pm as well as 2 fifteen-minute breaks. Housing is not offered for this program, but we can offer suggestions for both camping and hotels in our area. The cost for the Technicians program is \$1,500 and we require a deposit of \$750 to enroll and the remainder is due on the first day of class.

The class hours for both the Journeyman and the Masters Programs are Monday – Friday, 8 am – 5 pm with a one hour break for lunch from noon – 1:00 pm and two 15 minute breaks, one in the morning and one in the afternoon. We do need to work an occasional weekend day or in the evenings to stay on schedule or makeup time.

All deposits are fully refundable up to 30 days cancellation prior to the first day of the class. We will require a letter either faxed or mailed to notify us of these changes. All tuition and fees paid by the applicant shall be refunded if the applicant is rejected by the school before enrollment. An applicant fee of not more than \$25.00 may be retained by the school if the applicant is denied. All refunds shall be returned within 30 days.

One last item, we do recommend that you purchase a nice pair of safety glasses that fit very comfortably and have excellent coverage. We do supply these free of charge with adjustable temple length, but they are not always the best fit. If you already wear glasses be sure to find impact safe lenses with temple guards.
